

Hilleberg introduces the New Kaitum GT Tents

Seattle, WA,— Hilleberg the Tentmaker proudly introduces the new Kaitum 2 and 3 GT models for 2009. The original Kaitum tunnel tents are renowned for their spaciousness. But the extended vestibules on the new Kaitum 2 and 3 GT takes “spacious” into positively “expansive.” All season tough yet remarkably lightweight, the Kaitum GT models boast one standard vestibule as well as the extended one, easily providing space enough for gear-intensive outings from family backpacking to climbing.

“Both the two- and three-person Kaitum versions and their new GT counterparts are ideal for trips where light weight is a higher priority than maximum strength, but where true all-season capability is still a necessity” said Petra Hilleberg, President of Hilleberg USA. “It would be hard to find another tent that offers as much space and comfort at such a low weight as the Kaitum GT does.”

The ultralight Kerlon 1200 outer tent fabric used on the Kaitum GT models is easily the strongest ultra-lightweight tent fabric available. It provides all-condition durability for use in protected terrain in



any kind of weather and is robust enough to handle use in exposed terrain in all but the worst conditions. Additionally, the use of DAC Featherlite NSL poles keeps total weight to a minimum.

Appealing to backpackers, winter campers, hunters, climbers, bicycle or paddle tourers who want more room and flexibility, the Kaitum GT models’ two entrances and two vestibules afford tremendous convenience, flexibility and comfort. For instance, one vestibule can be designated for gear stowage, while the other can be used for food preparation.
